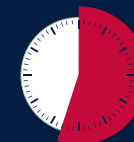

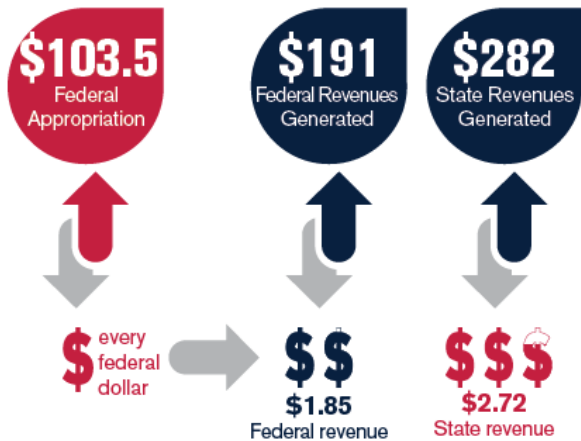

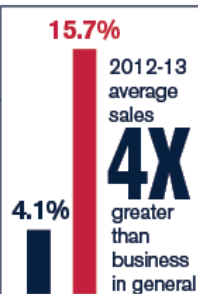
Cost vs. Revenue Generated by SBDCs in 2013
