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## Meet Matt Rissell

[Matt Rissell](#) is the Vice President for the TSheets Time Tracking Segment at Intuit, and he's the co-founder of TSheets, an Eagle, Idaho-based SaaS company that specializes in online, GPS-powered time tracking and scheduling apps for small businesses.

Matt started TSheets, his sixth successful startup venture, in 2006, after discovering a gap in the online employee time tracking market. Since then, TSheets has grown to over 300 employees, served customers across industries in more than 100 countries, and raised \$15 million in Series A growth equity funding. In early 2018, TSheets was acquired by Intuit for \$340M and the TSheets team joined the QuickBooks family.

TSheets was included on the 2016 Deloitte Fast500 list, has been awarded a Top Company Culture title by Entrepreneur, was named the Innovative Company of the Year by the Idaho Technology Council, and has been a Best Place to Work in Idaho four years running.

With a passion for startups, strategy, and identifying high-growth opportunities, Matt speaks at conferences nationwide and is a regular contributor to Forbes, AMEX Open Forum, and The Huffington Post. Determined to make "rural" Boise the next great tech hub, Matt has also worked to support the burgeoning tech community in Idaho, with features in the Wall Street Journal, The New York Times, Fortune, and other major publications.

Most recently, Matt has received the 40 Under 40 award from CPA Practice Advisor, an Accomplished Under 40 award from the Idaho Business Review, and a Rule Breaker award. He was named Idaho's 2017 Innovator of the Year as well as an Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year finalist.

A Colorado native, Matt enjoys spending time in the mountains of Idaho with his wife, three children, and Weimaraner, Brushy — bird hunting, bowhunting, and fishing. If that's not adventurous enough, he's also a pilot.
