The Green Teahouse is an award-winning retail shop established in 2009, and is in the upscale Westfarms Mall, in Farmington, Connecticut. They offer luxury loose-leaf teas from around the world, tea making accessories and specialty handcrafted Teas-to-Go. Online ordering, home delivery and in-store pick-up are also available through the store and website. Ting was born and raised in China, and immersed in its tea culture, which gives the shop genuine character and authenticity.

Ting has been working with Denise Whitford at the CTSBDC since 2014 where she benefits from technical assistance to guide her strategic business strategy, develop digital marketing tactics, and prepare various loan and grant applications to gain access to capital. Ting recently began a journey to secure Minority Business Certifications and engage in government contracting with the assistance of CTSBDC and Apex. CTSBDC also assisted Ting in assembling and applying for the EIDL and PPP programs in 2020 and for the WBDC matching grant program in 2021. She secured \$10,000 EIDL and \$34,000 PPP and \$10,00 from WBDC to stabilize and grow her business. Once retail stores were able to reopen after Covid, this funding provided Ting with the opportunity to pivot capital and human resources, rebuild her workforce, enhance her website, launch a social media and digital sales program.

Ting currently has 4 full-time employees and 14 part-time employees and is at a level comparative to pre-covid volume.

Ting's professional mindset and character set her apart from others in this highly competitive retail space. Despite challenges and setbacks, Ting gets great satisfaction and joy from seeing both her employees and customers smiling faces when they are in the tea shop. Owning, preserving, and growing the Teahouse has only strengthened her desire to do better. She truly practices her mantra that "life is not only about bettering ourselves, but it's also about making other people's lives better too."
